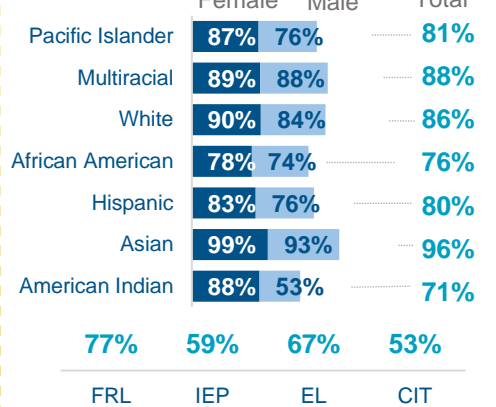

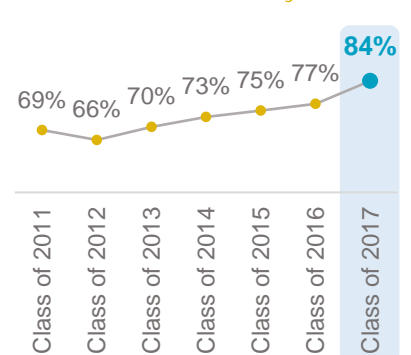

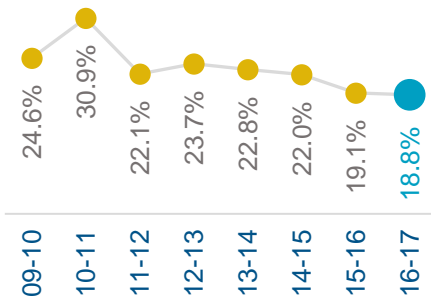
Graduation Rate by Year
